## PUBLIC EDUCATION.

In 2025, six candidates are competing in the Democratic gubernatorial primary. All claim to be pro-education, but only Sean Spiller is truly pro-education on *every issue, every time.* 

- Sean Spiller has **ALWAYS** advocated for full pension funding, unlike one of his opponents who voted for state budgets that failed to fund pensions and who refused to support a constitutional amendment requiring full funding, and unlike others who refuse to commit to fully funding them in the future.
- Sean Spiller has **ALWAYS** opposed any tier below Tier 1, unlike one opponent who worked with Chris Christie to create Tier 5 and unlike other opponents who haven't yet stepped up to support legislation restoring pension justice for all.
- Sean Spiller has **ALWAYS** stood for public education first, unlike some of his opponents who have close financial and political ties to individuals and groups that promote privatization, vouchers and corporate charter interests that would undermine and defund New Jersey's public schools.

- Sean Spiller **ALWAYS** stands with NJEA's local associations, unlike one opponent who has frequently supported anti-union school board slates.
- Sean Spiller has **NEVER** believed that charter schools deserve special treatment, unlike one of his opponents who was a board member for a huge national charter school chain before running for office.
- Sean Spiller has **NEVER** taken money from the people currently trying to tear down public education at the federal level, unlike some of his opponents who have taken donations from a superPAC tied to Elon Musk's SpaceX.

Being good on some education issues some of the time isn't good enough. We deserve a candidate who is great on every education issue every time.
